



**MINUTES OF
August 11, 2013

2. Secretary's Report (Steve Dellinger): Steve indicated that the minutes from the June 9th, 2013 meeting were not yet available.
3. Treasurer's Report was provided by Jim Harbold. Members may contact him for details. The Clubs continues to be on sound financial footing.
4. President's Report:
 - Ralph distributed an agenda – which included a “cheat sheet” of upcoming events on the back.
 - Jack Butler and his wife went to NAMGAR event in Asheville, NC (via portions of the Skyline Drive/Blue Ridge Parkway). There were approximately 200 (?) MGAs in attendance at the event. Next year's event will be held in Ottawa in July. There were three 1930's Austin 7's at the event – on an 11,000 mile trip from Buenos Aries to New York City.
 - Gloria and Larry attended shows in Hellertown, Lily Pons, and Pennypacker Mills.
 - Brooks Thompson talked briefly about the Red Lion Car Show, which is held every July 4th in Fairmount Park. His car won 1st in class (Modern Sports Cars).
 - Five (5) cars – but NO MG's – attended the Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix.

- Ten (10) people attended the tour of the Marshall Steam Museum in Delaware – which has the largest collection of Stanley Steamer cars in the country. The group then ate dinner at the Redfire Grill and Steakhouse.
- Name Tag Drawing for \$80 – Donna Dencler's name was pulled – she was not there, so the “pot” rolls over to \$90 for the September meeting.

5. Committee Reports:

- BIG – There were a total of 205 cars in attendance (including 149 preregistrations and 39 “no shows”). Bob indicated that the net profit for the event should be approximately \$2,300.

- Club survey – To date, approximately 66 percent have been returned. The results will be presented at the September meeting.

7. New Business:

- Club Name Change – A general discussion was held concerning the possibility of changing the name of the Club – since it caters to much more than just MG owners. No action was taken.
