MG2018 - FUNKHANA

- Richard Liddick needs a proposal by the beginning of October
- Date/time of the Funkhana is Wednesday, June 20th from 1-4 PM
- Maximum of 50 cars
- Estimate the need for 9 or 10 “workers” needed
- Area of parking lot (near the theater) has been identified – consists of three parking lanes
- Larry provided a draft layout – use tennis/wiffle balls - throw at targets and/or place on top of things (pylons); have a “spark plug remove/replace” station; include a “back into a parking space” station; more to refine
- Registration/hotel reservations not open yet; several members intend to stay on site

BIG –2018

- The date set for next year's show is July 8th
- Bob A. said that the Outlet's Marketing Manager has indicated that we will not be able to park on Main Street next year. They said that we can set up in the parking lot on the Route 15 side of the site – near TGI Fridays. Reason given – hurts sales in the stores (which ones? certainly not the Food Court)
- Someone needs to visit the Outlets on a Sunday morning – say 11:30 AM – to see/count how many customer cars are there
- After Sunday morning reconnaissance, Bob, Larry and Ralph will try to set up a meeting with the Outlets Manager and Marketing Manager to discuss
- Board consensus – no Main Street parking – no Show!

TOB – 2018

- Larry will not chair a show if held at Forney Field next year
- Discussion of alternate show locations – Garrett Field (Willow Street); Lions Park (Rothsville); Warwick Township Complex (Clay Road); Park in Lititz – location in the Lititz area preferred
- General information on the Warwick/Lititz locations was discussed
- Park in Lititz may be hard to get to/locate
- Lions Park is very close to the Forney Field; has a pavilion and permanent restrooms, some paved parking, trees
- Warwick Township Complex (Clay Road) is primarily play fields; has a pavilion and permanent restrooms, few trees
- A reconnaissance of the Lions Park and Clay Road facilities is scheduled for Tuesday (9/12) – we will meet at the McDonalds (990 Lititz Pike) in the Shoppes at Kissel Hill on 501 (north of the Airport) at 10 AM
