- Ralph introduced new member Russ Vollmer from Lancaster. Russ has a 1952 BRG TD, which was restored in 2001.
- Trivia Questions – Ralph asked two questions: When did the first races start at Watkins Glen? Russ Vollmer correctly answered the question (the answer was – 1952). The second question: When was NAMGBR's MGB Register established? Forrest Collier correctly guessed the answer (which was 1990).
